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
#### **Empower Women to Make the World a Better Place**

#### **Campus Recruitment Training**

Mr. Jugjit Sing Jumra, Director, HSM Immigration Services was the speaker for the session. He emphasized on the issues of decision making in choosing a global university for higher education. He also stressed on different courses and the cultural differences the students face in choosing abroad education and advised the students how to live, how to study within a different culture and how to thrive elsewhere from home that increases the level of confidence that can be beneficial in the longer term. #### Orientation on "Ambedkar Overseas Vidya Nidhi Scheme"

To assist the weaker section and to enable them to compete in the job market to get suitable jobs an orientation session on "Ambedkar Overseas Vidya Nidhi Scheme" was organized by SC/ST cell on 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 in association with Telangana State Scheduled caste Development Department and COIGN Consultants Pvt. Ltd, Hyderabad. Mr. Pradeep, Trainer, COIGN consultants was the speaker for the session. He explained about the courses which will actually help ST/SC students to clear the exams like GRE, IELTS, TOEFL, GMAT, PTE which in turn leads to study various courses in countries like USA, Canada, UK, Australia, Singapore, New Zealand, France, and Japan. He emphasized on how trainings enable the students in understanding the nuances of these courses according to the social situations and stressed upon the importance of learning and exhibiting these skills for studying abroad.



#### Workshop on "Micro Analysis of Financial Statements"

Financial statements give the reader an overview of the financial activity of a corporation between two sets of dates. They tell the accumulated financial story of a business at the end of the accounting period and how the business owner's idea has translated into financial success or despair. The ability to make sense of financial statements and to have a coherent view of a business financial health or to estimate the value of private businesses is an essential skill that any underwriter should possess and sharpen. Analysis of Financial Statement is a very important part of curriculum in Management Studies.

To strengthen the financial concepts of the students and its practicalities a one day workshop organized by IQAC on "Micro Analysis of Financial Statements" was organized on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2019. Dr. S. Chandrasekhar, Corporate Trainer and CEO of Empover HR Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore was the resource person. The workshop provided unique tips for students in analyzing financial statements. It was conducted in two sessions. In the morning session the speaker explained about the topics of financial analysis, effect of revised schedule IV on tools of financial statements. He has given practical exercises and provided hands on experience to the students. In the afternoon session he discussed about critical ratio analysis, accounting principles, accounting standards, asset liability management, and other basics of accounting. The students have actively participated in the workshop and learnt accounting concepts in detail in simplest way. Around one hundred fifty students of MBA I year II Semester students attended the workshop.





#### **International Women's Day**

International Women's Day is a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women on 8<sup>th</sup> March every year. #### World Consumer Rights Day

The US President John F Kennedy formally addressed the issue of consumer rights on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 1962 in the US Congress. He was the first world leader to address this issue. The first World Consumer Rights Day was observed on 15<sup>th</sup> March 1983. The theme for this year was 'Trusted Smart Products', A Smart Product can connect, share and interact with its user and other devices.

#### World Water Day

World Water Day is held annually on  $22^{nd}$  March as a means of focusing attention on the importance of fresh water and advocating for the sustainable management of fresh water resources. United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) recommended in 1992 to celebrate fresh water as an International day of celebration. The United Nations General Assembly responded by designating  $22^{nd}$  March, 1993 as the first World Water Day. World Water Day is an international observance and an opportunity to learn more about water related issues, be inspired to tell others and take action to make a difference by promoting public awareness through the production and dissemination of documentaries and organizing conferences, seminars and expositions related to the conservation and development of water resources and the implementation of the recommendations. The Theme for World Water Day- 2019 is 'Leaving no one behind,' which is the central promise of the 2030 Agenda for 'Sustainable Development' as sustainable development progresses, everyone must benefit. The focus of 'Leave no one behind,' is to put the efforts towards including people who have been ignored in providing fresh water. Water services must meet the needs of various groups of people and no one has to be ignored.

To inspire students and to learn more about water-related issues and to take action to make a difference, World Water Day was celebrated on  $22^{nd}$  March, 2019 by Nature Club-Adhira. On this occasion, a seminar was organized on the theme "Leaving no one behind". Students spoke about various issues related to water and the ways in which water crisis can be tackled. Students participated actively and expressed their views on importance of water. They also suggested measures on improving the health and reducing the diseases through water initiatives. Around hundred students of MBA I year participated actively in the seminar.



#### SHE TEAM "V R 1Run"

SHE Teams was introduced in the State in 2014 with a motto to provide safety and security to women and to curb crimes against women. Bharosa is an integrated support centre for women and children established by the city police in 2016. It was formed with the aim of curbing eve teasing in all aspects, in all forms, at all places, providing safety and security to women in the society, facilitating healthy environment for women's mobility thereby building up confidence in women to fulfill the Telangana Government commitment of safe and secure Hyderabad City to women. According to the Bharosa and SHE Teams, "V R 1" is an effort to get maximum people from all walks of life, especially students, professionals and children, to participate in the run so as to inculcate the habit of looking at each other with respect and make Hyderabad one of the safest cities in the world.

On the occasion of International Women's Day the SHE Teams division of the Hyderabad City Police organized a run on 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 at People's Plaza on Necklace Road in Hyderabad. The run, titled 'V R 1', was the first event under the banner V R 1, a unique initiative set up by the Bharosa and SHE Teams, who have been actively hosting programmes and events for women's safety and dignity in the city. The run was divided into three categories – 10 km, 5 km and 2 km. The event flagged off with the 10 km run which begun at 6.30 pm. The Hon'ble Governor Sri. E.S.L. 


