Women Empowerment: It's Meaning and Why Is It Important


Nobel Laureate Malala Yousafzai famously quoted "I raise up my voice—not so I can shout, but so that those without a voice can be heard...we cannot succeed when half of us are held back.", and that sentiment precisely outlines the basis of new age women empowerment. Discrimination against women is rampant all over the world even in this 21st century. Patriarchal societies in most countries are adept at exploitation as well as victimization of women. Even though about 50% of the world's population consists of women, but unfortunately most of them are denied basic rights education, freedom of speech, voting power and even independent identity. Crimes directed specifically against women are reported from all over the world. There still remain questions about acceptance of women empowerment in the most advanced of countries, while developing nations and nations under political duress are far from achieving the desired status.

In India, in theory, women enjoy a status of equality with the men as per constitutional and legal provisions. Arguably, our country has taken enormous strides towards inclusion of women with the fairer gender excelling in diverse fields, from literature to astrophysics to finance. But with headlines about dowry killing, female foeticides and domestic violence still making the newspapers, put a silent question mark behind the two words. Here, in this current age, true development and growth can only be achieved by taking successful strides in eliminating deep-rooted ideologies of gender bias and discrimination like the confinement of women to the private domestic realm, restrictions on their mobility, poor access to health services, nutrition, education and employment, and exclusion from the public and political sphere.

Women constitute roughly 50% of the nation's population and a majority of them remain economically dependent, without employment. Many of them are even unaware of the fact that they are eligible for positions that men enjoy. The result is that the economy of the country is skewed due to underutilization of available human resources. Women are generally considered less competent, both intellectually as well as physically as compared with men. As a result the opportunities extended towards them become biased and obtrusive without actual evaluation of their competencies. While scientific data proclaims women to be more adept at multi-tasking than men, they still remain the second choice for employers in the country.

Guest Lecture on "Stress Management"



Students are one of the most common victims of stress. Factors such as financial expenses, over commitment, family expectations, deadlines and workload all induce stress in students. While a mild amount of stress is very useful and acts as a motivation for students, too much stress can interfere with their daily lives. When built over time, stress can give rise to a host of serious problems such as depression and anxiety. Many students find that they need to develop new skills in order to balance academic demands with a healthy lifestyle.

MBA students are on the verge of stepping into the "Professional world" that encompasses in itself opportunities as well as challenges. These are the cause of a sense of achievement but are accompanied

with pressure to perform and excel. So it becomes imperative for any professional institute to provide its students with necessary inputs in this direction. With this note a Guest Lecture was organized on 14th, March, 2018 for the students of MBA I Year II Semester on "Stress Management" by Mr. Anjaneyulu. The Orator cited the definition of the word "stress" as given by the Oxford Dictionary which is "A state of affair involving demand on physical or mental energy". Today, with the rapid diversification of human activity, especially in the professional arena, we come face to face with numerous causes of stress and the symptoms of anxiety and depression. He also emphasized that stress, in moderate doses, is necessary in our life. Research suggests that stress can actually increase our performance. Instead of wilting under stress, one can use it as an impetus to achieve success. Under stress the brain is emotionally and biochemically stimulated to sharpen its performance. But taking stress positively and as a Catalyst for growth requires self motivation along with pertinent guidance. Here comes the role of Stress Management which is the amelioration of stress and especially chronic stress often for the purpose of improving everyday functioning. It was an interactive session where the students learnt to balance and relax their professional life and take stress as a performance booster and not hindrance thus "Creating Excellence through positive competition".



Guest Lecture on "SAP Technologies"

In data processing, SAP is a short form for Systems, Applications and Products. Most of the companies considered that SAP solution has the extremely vital factor for their businesses. Many companies widely use the SAP system for daily operations and reporting. More than 120 countries around the world, SAP is present.
